COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1036, L.D. 1388, Bill, "An Act Concerning Reasonable Standards and Procedures for Contracting Services by the State"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1816-A.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "civil service" and inserting in its place the following: 'the state agency'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1816-A.~~" in subsection 2 in paragraph F in the first line (page 2, line 41 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "firm" the following: 'or a licensed, registered or otherwise professionally qualified individual'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1816-A.~~" in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph G and inserting in its place the following:

'G. The firm to which the contract is awarded has no more than a total of 3 occupational safety and health or labor law violations within the previous 5 calendar years.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1816-A.~~" in subsection 3 in the 5th line (page 3, line 14 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "contracted" the following: ', the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1816-A.~~" in subsection 3 in the 7th line (page 3, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "contracted" and inserting in its place the following: 'contacted'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1816-A.~~" in subsection 3 in the 8th line from the end (page 3, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "5" and inserting in its place the following: '3 business'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1816-A.~~" in subsection 5 in the first line. (page 3, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "The Bureau of General Services" and inserting in its place the following: 'Each state agency'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1816-A.~~" in subsection 5 in the 5th line (page 3, line 41 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "matters" the following: 'and to the Bureau of General Services'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

**Sec. 3. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

The Bureau of General Services within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services will require General Fund appropriations of \$14,141 and \$15,088 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively, for a part-time staff person who is required to comply with the new standards for Personal Services contracting.

State departments and agencies that contract for Personal Services can absorb any costs related to submitting a report on this contracting to the Bureau of General Services and the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes several changes to the bill for clarification purposes and shortens a request for notification to 3 business days from 5 days. The amendment removes environmental violations as one of the contract conditions and adds the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government in the procedure for notification. The amendment also adds an appropriations section and a fiscal note.
