SENATE AMENDMENT "" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 14 1038, L.D. 1390, Bill, "An Act to Strengthen the Public Disclosure of Lobbying Activities" 16

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the 18 following:

20 'Amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 9 in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 1 and 2 in L.D.) by striking out the 22 following: ', or to solicit or urge others to communicate directly,' and by striking out all of the last underlined 24 sentence (page 2, lines 10 and 11 in L.D.)'

26 Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by 28 striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 10 by striking out all of the last stricken out sentence (page 1, lines 23 to 27 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following: ' 'Lobbyist" shall does not include an-individual-who-ic-a-partner, associate,-member-or-employee-of-a-partnership,-firm,-corporation of or-professional-association-which-has-been-employed-for-lobbying when-that-individual-is-acting-for-the-lobbyist-in-representing the-employer a lobbyist associate.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment clarifies that lobbyists and lobbyist associates are 2 separate terms and that the registration form 6 and disclosure reports are to be filed by the lobbyist.

8 The amendment clarifies that lobbying means communicating directly with legislative officials or the Governor for the 10 purpose of influencing legislation.
