HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1049, L.D. 1401, "Resolve, to Create the Healthy Start Task Force"

Amend the resolve in section 3 by striking out all of subsection 9 and inserting in its place the following:

'9. Six public members appointed on the basis of expertise, experience and interest in the prevention of child abuse and neglect or expertise and experience in intervention in cases of child abuse and neglect. Of these 6 public members, 2 members must be appointed by the President of the Senate, one of whom is recommended by the Senate Chair of the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources, 2 members must be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, one of whom is recommended by the House Chair of the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources and 2 members must be appointed by the Governor; and be it further'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment revises the provision specifying appointing authorities for the public members of the Healthy Start Task Force to provide that the President of the Senate appoints 2 members one of whom is recommended by the Senate Chair of the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources, the Speaker of the House of Representatives appoints 2 members one of whom is recommended by the House Chair of the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources and the Governor appoints 2 members.
