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1.0	§900-H. Budget; appropriations and approval
12	Notwithstanding sections 2, 701 and 702, in Penobscot Count the county commissioners may appropriate money, according to

18	This section establishes the Penobscot County Budge Advisory Committee, referred to in this article as the "budge

22	1. Appointment. Each county commissioner shall appoint municipal officials from the commissioner's respective count

26	2. Municipal official elections. Before September 30th of every year, the county commissioners shall notify all municipal every year.

18	4. Municipal official; definition. The term "municipa official," as it refers to the budget advisory committee in thi
	section, means any elected or appointed member of a municipa

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government.

## §900-J. Budget process

- 1. Public hearing. The Penobscot County commissioners shall hold one or more public hearings on the budget estimate at times convenient for the residents of the county and before November 1st of each year.
- Budget estimate; submission to budget advisory 10 committee. The Penobscot County commissioners shall submit a budget estimate for the coming year to the budget advisory committee no later than November 1st of each year. The budget 12 advisory committee shall review the budget estimate and prepare 14 the budget. The budget must be presented to the county commissioners by December 1st of each year. The county 16 commissioners shall act on the budget in a timely fashion, not later than December 15th of the year preceding the budget year. 18 If the adopted budget is changed by the county commissioners, the budget advisory committee may reject that change by a 4/5 vote of 20 its membership. Those actions are final and not subject to further action by either the county commissioners or the budget 22 advisory committee.
  - 3. Final budget; filing. A copy of the final budget must be submitted to the legislative delegation for Penobscot County who must approve or disapprove but may not change the budget. If the county legislative delegation disapproves the budget, the budget advisory committee may override that disapproval by a 4/5 vote or adopt a new final budget, which is not submitted to the county legislative delegation, by a 4/5 vote. A copy of the final budget must be filed on forms approved by the Department of Audit. The State Auditor shall retain the budget for 3 years.
- 4. Interim budget. If the budget is not approved before the start of the fiscal year, the county must operate on an interim budget that does not exceed the budget of the previous year until a final budget is adopted.
