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- Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §763, sub-\$1, ¶¶A and B, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 749, §1, are amended to read:
 - Before September 15th of every year, the county commissioners shall notify all municipal officers in the county to caucus by county commissioner districts at a specified date, time and place for the purpose of electing at least one municipal officer from each district as a member of the budget advisory committee except, -in-1992, -at least--3--municipal--officers--must--be--selected--from--each district. The county commissioner shall serve as nonvoting moderator for that district caucus. Nominations must be received from the floor. The nominee receiving the most votes is approved as a budget advisory committee member except, --in-1992, --each-eaucus-shall-elect-3-members. names of those elected by the caucus must be recorded and forwarded to the county commissioners.
 - B. Budget advisory committee members serve 3-year terms except, -in -1992, -one-member-from each district must-be elected for a one-year term, one-member for a 2-year term and on more than one member from each municipality may serve at a time. If a budget advisory committee member ceases to be a municipal officer during the term of membership, that committee member vacates membership and the next district caucus shall elect a qualified municipal officer to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §765, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 749, §1, is amended to read:

§765. Budget estimate; submission to advisory committee

The Hancock County commissioners shall submit a budget estimate to the budget advisory committee no later than October 1st for the coming year. The budget advisory committee shall review the budget estimate and make recommendations to the commissioners before November 15th. The county commissioners shall act on the budget in-a-timely-fashion-and, in-any-event, net no later than December 15th of the budget year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill clarifies that the Hancock County commissioners must act on recommendations by December 15th of the budget year and provides that no more than one committee member from each municipality may serve at a time. The bill also removes from the law obsolete language concerning appointment dates.
