## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment adds a preamble to the bill requiring approval by a 2/3 vote of the membership of each House so that 4 the State is not required to fund 90% of the costs imposed on 6 local governments by the bill as provided in the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21. The amendment also adds a fiscal 8 note.
