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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1083, L.D. 1449, Bill, "An Act to Make Statutory Changes to Implement the Recommendations of the Legislature's Total Quality Management Committee"

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Amend the amendment in Part A in section 4 in that part designated "§154." by striking out all of the last indented paragraph (page 2, lines 40 to 44 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

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'Notwithstanding the other provisions of this chapter, if the Governor posts a nomination within 30 days preceding the statutory date of adjournment, a legislative committee to whom a nominee is to be referred for confirmation review may, by 2/3 vote, request the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives to delay this review in order to complete the committee's legislative work. If the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives approve the request, the time periods for legislative action under this chapter begin on the date the Legislature adjourns.'

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Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 4 in that part designated "§157." in the first indented paragraph in the first line (page 3, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the following: "40" and inserting in its place the following: '30'

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Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 4 in that part designated "§157." in the first indented paragraph in the 3rd line (page 3, line 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "45" and inserting in its place the following: '35'

following: "50" and inserting in its place the following: '40'

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12 Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 4 in that
part designated "\$158." in the first indented paragraph in the
14 3rd line (page 4, line 49 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "55" and inserting in its place the following: '45'

16 Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 4 in that
part designated "\$158." in the first indented paragraph in the
18 5th line (page 5, line 1 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "60" and inserting in its place the following: '50'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment maintains the current time period for
26 legislative confirmations except in the last month of the
legislative session when a legislative committee has inadequate
time to conduct a confirmation review proceeding. During the
28 last month of a legislative session, a committee to whom a
nominee has been referred for review may by a 2/3 vote request
30 the presiding officers for an extension if that committee is
unable to conduct the review because of the committee's work
