STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment maintains the current time period for legislative confirmations except in the last month of the legislative session when a legislative committee has inadequate time to conduct a confirmation review proceeding. During the last month of a legislative session, a committee to whom a nominee has been referred for review may by a 2/3 vote request the presiding officers for an extension if that committee is unable to conduct the review because of the committee's work schedule.
