COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1084, L.D. 1450, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Operation of Aircraft under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor or Drugs"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement 18 of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes a new Class D crime. Sentences imposed for Class D offenses must be served in a county jail. The average cost per sentence for a Class D crime is \$7,439 based upon an average length of stay of 119 days. The additional costs to the counties for the housing of each offender sentenced under this new crime will not require reimbursement by the State.

The Judicial Department may require additional General Fund appropriations to cover indigent defense costs related to these new cases. The amounts can not be estimated at this time. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial administrative Department's account. The collection of additional fines may also increase General Fund revenues by a minor amount.

The additional costs to pay for testing aircraft pilots for drug/alcohol abuse can be absorbed by the Department of Transportation utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note.

The Department of Corrections has prepared the following correctional impact statement pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-A, section 1402: "L.D. 1450, An Act Concerning the Operation of Aircraft under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor or Drugs creates a new Class D offense for violation of this proposed section. A sentence imposed for a Class D offense must be served in a county jail facility. Looking at sentences served for Class D offenses in county jails, the average length of stay was found to be about 119 days. The average costs per day in a county jail are \$62.51. The average cost per sentence for a Class D crime is \$7,439."
