This bill provides General Fund appropriations to the Maine Technical College System of \$2,200,000 in fiscal year 1993-94 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 1994-95 to implement the worker retraining program.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill and provides funding for the worker retraining program at \$2,200,000 in fiscal year 1993-94 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 1994-95 from the General Fund. The program would provide education and job training at the Maine Technical College System to unemployed workers.

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
