HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 478,
L.D. 1477, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the
Special Commission on Electoral Practices"

Amend the amendment in section 31 by striking out all of
subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'2. **Influence prohibited.** Within 250 feet of the entrance
to the voting place as well as within the voting place itself, no
a person may not influence or attempt to influence another
person's ~~choice of candidates~~ decision regarding a candidate or
ballot issue. This limitation does not prohibit a candidate from
attending the voting place and orally communicating with voters,
as long as he the candidate does not attempt to influence their
vote."

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows candidates to be present at voting
places.
