Amend the amendment in section 19 in subsection 2 in  
paragraph A in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 6, lines 36 and 37 in  
amendment) by striking out the following: "who are nominated as  
provided in subsection 1" and inserting in its place the  
following: '~~who are nominated as provided in subsection 1~~ with  
the same representation of parties and unenrolled voters as  
required by subsection 1'

Further amend the amendment in section 19 in subsection 2 in  
paragraph B in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 6, lines 40 and 41 in  
amendment) by striking out the following: "who are nominated as  
provided in subsection 1" and inserting in its place the  
following: '~~who are nominated as provided in subsection 1~~ with  
the same representation of parties and unenrolled voters as  
required by subsection 1'

Further amend the amendment in section 19 in subsection 2 in  
paragraph C in the 3rd line (page 6, line 46 in amendment) by  
striking out the following: "who are nominated as provided in  
subsection 1" and inserting in its place the following: '~~who are  
nominated as provided in subsection 1~~ with the same  
representation of parties and unenrolled voters as required by  
subsection 1'
