HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 478,
L.D. 1477, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the
Special Commission on Electoral Practices"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 1, 13,
29, 47 and 48.

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment restores the reasons a voter may qualify for
an absentee ballot. The amendment removes the provisions
allowing absentee ballots on request. The amendment corrects
cross-references.
