
SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 478, L.D. 1477, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Special Commission on Electoral Practices"

Amend the amendment in section 30 in that part designated "~~§674.~~" in subsection 4 in paragraph A by striking out the last 2 sentences.

Further amend the amendment in section 54 in that part designated "~~§829.~~" by striking out the last 2 sentences.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the provisions of the committee amendment that take away the right to vote for 3 years of any person convicted of a violation of 2 election law provisions: tampering with ballots or voting lists or opening sealed packages of ballots and illegal alteration of a voting machine.
