
SENATE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 478, L.D. 1477, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Special Commission on Electoral Practices"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 2, 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 14 and 28.

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the proposed changes relating to deputy registrars and removes the sections of the amendment that repeal the provisions of current law governing boards of registration of voters.
