SENATE AMENDMENT "G" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 478, L.D. 1477, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Special Commission on Electoral Practices"

Amend the amendment in section 9 in subsection 1 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 3, lines 44 and 45 in amendment) by striking out all of the following: "~~and to which, whenever he is absent, he has the intention to return~~" and inserting in its place the following: ', and to which, whenever he that person is absent, he that person has the intention to return'

Further amend the amendment in section 16 in subsection 2 in the 4th and 5th lines (page 5, lines 30 and 31 in amendment) by striking out all of the following: "~~with an apparent intention of abandoning their residence in the municipality~~" and inserting in its place the following: 'with an apparent intention of abandoning their residence in the municipality'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the change proposed to the law governing residence as a place to which a voter intends to return.
