4	This amendment amends language recently enacted that prohibits cable television operators from charging a penalty for
6	late payment of a cable bill. This amendment clarifies that if a bill includes separate charges for different levels of service, a
8	late fee must be calculated on the total amount overdue for all levels of service. This amendment also specifies that a payment
10	is not late until 45 days after the services to which the late fee applies have been received by the consumer.
