Amend the resolve by inserting after section 6 the following:

'Sec. 7. Expenses. Resolved: That expenses or reimbursement is not authorized for members of the team. The Department of Human Services and the Department of Labor shall absorb the costs of preparing and distributing the team's report; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services and the Department of Labor will incur some minor additional costs to participate on a transition team to study the restructuring of certain welfare functions and to support the costs related to the required report. These costs can be absorbed within the respective departments' existing budgeted resources.

The Executive Department will incur some minor additional costs to participate on the transition team. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'
