An Act to Enable the Creation of the Volunteer Social Workers' Project.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §7031 is enacted to read:

§7031. Volunteer Social Workers' Project

The board shall contract with a statewide agency or entity that represents social workers to establish and administer the Volunteer Social Workers' Project. The project shall, pursuant to the contract and in accordance with procedures and protocols developed by the project and approved by the board, match persons referred by social service agencies and providers with social workers who have agreed to provide their services on a pro bono basis. In addition, the project shall develop opportunities for social workers to participate on a pro bono basis in community organization activities. The project must be funded from surcharges and fees set in section 7056. The project may also accept gifts, grants or other income from outside sources to supplement this funding.

Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §7056, as amended by PL 1987, c. 113, \S 2, is further amended to read:

24 §7056. Application; fees

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26 Application An application for a license as a licensed clinical, licensed master or licensed social worker shall must be on a form prescribed and furnished by the board. An application 28 fee and an examination fee may be established by the board in 30 amounts which that are reasonable and necessary for their respective purposes. A11 fees shall must accompany the 32 application.

34 The <u>board shall establish the</u> license fee for a licensed social worker shall-be-established-by-the-beard in an amount not 36 to exceed \$79 <u>\$85</u>.

38 The <u>board shall establish the</u> license fee for a licensed master social worker shall-be-established-by-the-beard in an 40 amount not to exceed \$119 \$125.

The <u>board shall establish the</u> license fee for a licensed clinical social worker shall-be-established-by-the-beard in an
amount not to exceed \$175 <u>\$190</u>.

 46 Fifteen dollars of each of the fees established by this section must be utilized by the board for the operation of the
48 Volunteer Social Workers' Project established pursuant to section 7031.

Fees for initial and renewal licenses shall <u>must</u> be set so 52 that total fee receipts do not exceed the amount required to cover properly the expense of performing the duties imposed upon 54 the board. If the board denies the issuance of a license to any applicant, the application and examination fees shall--be are nonrefundable.

Sec. 3. Surcharge established. The State Board of Social Worker Licensure shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Act, assess a \$15 surcharge on licensed social workers, master social workers and clinical social workers. Payment of the surcharge is a condition of continued licensure. The income from the surcharge must be used by the board to provide start-up funding for the Volunteer Social Workers' Project.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill establishes the Volunteer Social Workers' Project, which will be operated by a statewide agency representing social 18 workers under a contract with the State Board of Social Worker Licensure.

The project matches persons and organizations that need services with social workers who have agreed to provide services on a pro bono basis. Start-up funds for the project are provided by a one-time surcharge on social worker licenses of \$15 and ongoing funding will be provided by increasing the fee for those licenses by \$15.
