COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

'Sec. 4. Preparation of responses; cost estimate. Resolved: That the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation and the Department of Corrections shall utilize the document "Recommendations and Report of the Task Force on Persons with Mental Disorders Involved with the Criminal Justice System" and such additional research necessary to formulate responses to the issues posed in this resolve and that the response must include a cost estimate required to implement the recommendations.

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation and the Department of Corrections will incur some minor additional costs to jointly develop and submit the required proposals. These costs can be absorbed within the respective departments' existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The original resolve requires the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation and the Department of Corrections to develop a proposal for a secure forensic holding unit for evaluation of prisoners and to propose alternatives to incarceration for some persons with mental illness.

The Joint Select Committee on Corrections finds that the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation's document, "Recommendations and Report of the Task Force on Persons with Mental Disorders Involved with the Criminal Justice System," January 1993, does not adequately address all the issues posed in the resolve and does not provide implementing legislation or funding information. This amendment requires that the issues in the resolve be specifically addressed and the necessary funding information be provided.
