SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 487, L.D. 1498, "Resolve, to Transfer the Responsibilities of the Division for the Blind and Visually Impaired from the Department of Human Services to the Department of Education"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 2nd indented paragraph in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 2, lines 3 and 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "include the independent federal rehabilitation plan and to"

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in the 2nd indented paragraph in the 6th line (page 2, line 6 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Education." the following: 'The proposed legislation must include an independent rehabilitation plan for services for the blind and visually impaired within the Division for the Blind and Visually Impaired.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes clear that the independent federal rehabilitation plan referred to in the committee amendment applies to the Division for the Blind and Visually Impaired.
