SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 490, L.D. 1501, Bill, "An Act to Modify Various Licensing Board Laws"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the following:

'PART A'

Further amend the amendment in the first line after the title (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after the 3rd indented paragraph the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'PART B

Sec. B-1. 30-A MRSA §4221, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Inspections and permits not required. Plumbing inspections and permits are not required for:

A. Minor plumbing work or minor installations that are performed in compliance with state laws and rules if that plumbing work or those installations are done inside the structure of a private residence by the owner of that residence; and

B. Installation of domestic heating appliances by master
oil burner technicians licensed pursuant to Title 32,
chapter 33.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment amends the laws governing plumbing regulations to provide that plumbing inspections and permits are not required for minor plumbing work and minor installations that are done in a private residence by the owner of that residence and for installation of domestic heating appliances by master oil burner technicians licensed under Title 32.
