HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1110, L.D. 1506, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Municipal Elections"

Amend the amendment in section 13 in that part designated "§2531-A." by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 7, lines 45 to 50 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Written request. The candidate must request the recount by filing a written request with the municipal clerk within the time period provided in this section. The written request must state the office for which that person was a candidate and the reason for the recount based on the candidate's own knowledge or on information and belief.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that a candidate request a recount by filing a written request rather than by filing the notarized request required by the committee amendment.
