COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 496, L.D. 1516, "Resolve, Authorizing the Conveyance of Certain Public Lands in Gray"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "system." and inserting in its place the following: 'system; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 1 the following:

**Sec. 2. Authorization to supply water. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation may enter into an agreement with the United States of America, by and through the Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, referred to in this section as the "government," to supply water from Pineland Center to facilities constructed by the government on land conveyed to the government pursuant to this resolve.

8 additional associated costs can be absorbed utilizing existing  
9 budgeted resources.
