COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1125, L.D. 1524, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Revenues of the Board of Examiners of Podiatrists"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 and before the emergency clause the following:

**Sec. 2. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Increasing the amount of the licensing fee from \$100 to \$125, changing licensure terms from biennial to annual and making a one-time change in the date for collecting license fees will decrease dedicated revenues to the Board of Examiners of Podiatrists by \$8,800 in fiscal year 1992-93 and will increase dedicated revenues by \$18,000 and \$200 for fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively.

The board will require additional allocations of \$29,994 and \$4,862 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively, to allow the board to spend the additional revenues, certain unallocated revenues and a balance brought forward of \$16,000 for ongoing expenses and certain overdue bills.
