COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 509, L.D. 1535, Bill, "An Act to Expand Opportunities for School-to-work Transition Services Utilizing the Jobs for Maine's Graduates Model"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes the Jobs for Maine's Graduates program. The Office of the Governor within the Executive Department will incur some minor additional costs to appoint the Board of Directors, to accept grants, donations and other funds on behalf of Jobs for Maine's Graduates and to transfer those funds to the corporation. These costs can be absorbed within the Office of the Governor's existing budgeted resources.

The Governor's proposed current services budget includes net General Fund appropriations of \$70,440 and \$72,611 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively, for the Jobs for Maine's Graduates program within the Department of Labor. No additional General Fund appropriations are required.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
