Sec. 1. Joint Standing Committee on Taxation authorized to study 2 assessment practices. Resolved: That the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation is authorized to study the tax assessment practices 4 of municipalities regarding mobile homes, travel trailers and similar structures intended to be used human other for habitation; and be it further

Sec. 2. Duties. Resolved: That the committee shall collect, 8 review, analyze and compare samples of municipal ordinances, actual municipal assessments and municipal assessment practices, -10methodologies and techniques regarding mobile homes, travel 12 trailers and similar structures. The committee shall recommend any changes in law, rule, regulation or ordinance necessary to ensure a fair, consistent and equitable just valuation of mobile 14 homes, travel trailers and similar structures pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 8; and be it further 16

Sec. 3. Reimbursement. Resolved: That the members of the committee are entitled to the legislative per diem, pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, for attendance at up to 3 committee meetings and hearings per day; and be it further

Sec. 4. Report. Resolved: That the committee shall submit its report, together with any necessary implementing legislation and 24 proposed rules, to the Second Regular Session of the 116th Legislature no later than December 15, 1993; and be it further 26

Sec. 5. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are 28 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of 30 this resolve.
