SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1141, L.D. 1541, Bill, "An Act Authorizing a Referendum to Ratify the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact with Maine and Vermont and Approving the Compact's Terms"

Amend the amendment on page 4 by inserting after the first paragraph the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

Sec. 6. Payment for referendum costs. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the Maine Low-level Radioactive Waste Authority must transfer \$95,000 from the assessment authorized pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 1535 to the Department of the Secretary of State for the referendum costs associated with this Act.

Sec. 7. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act:

Provides for the allocation of funds for the referendum costs associated with this Act.'


