SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 523, L.D. 1545, "Resolve, Authorizing the Ellsworth School Department to Transact a Land Exchange to Avoid Wetlands and Ledge Discovered During Project Development of the New Ellsworth High School"

Amend the resolve by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as an emergency measure, the school construction project already underway for Ellsworth High School will be seriously jeopardized;

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.


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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 523, L.D. 1545
