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

L.D. 1549, Bill, "An Act to Set Voluntary Limits for Campaign  
Spending"

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph C in the first 3  
lines (page 1, lines 17 to 19 in L.D.) by striking out the  
following: "10 days after appointing a political committee, and  
before accepting contributions, making expenditures or incurring  
obligations" and inserting in its place the following: 'April  
11th'

This amendment changes the filing date to April 11th, which  
is 10 days after the April 1st deadline for candidates in a  
primary election.
