28	This bill establishes a new program dealing with voluntary limits on campaign spending for certain statewide and countywide

32	budgeted resources. The commission can not implement the requirements of this bill without additional General Fund
34	appropriations of \$126,618 and \$87,693 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively, to provide funds for a Clerk Typist
36	II, a Data Entry Specialist, a Research and Planning Assistant I,
38	general operating expenses and capital equipment needs to develop a computerized campaign spending tracking system.
40	This bill requires candidates who participate in voluntary limits and who exceed the amount set by law to pay the full
42	amount that exceeds the limit to the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices. The amounts of additional
44	dedicated revenues generated by this provision can not be
