SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1149, L.D. 1549, Bill, "An Act to Set Voluntary Limits for Campaign Spending"

Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of the first line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:


'Sec. 3. 21-A MRSA §1015, sub-§§7 to 9 are enacted to read:'

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of subsection 9.

Further amend the bill in section 3 by renumbering all of the subsections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment eliminates contribution limitations of \$100 per source for state and county candidates who do not voluntarily limit political expenditures.
