
SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to H.P. 1149, L.D. 1549, Bill, "An Act to Set Voluntary Limits for Campaign Spending"

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph C in the first 3 lines (page 1, lines 17 to 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "10 days after appointing a political committee, and before accepting contributions, making expenditures or incurring obligations" and inserting in its place the following: 'April 11th in the election year'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the filing date to April 11th in the election year, which is 10 days after the April 1st deadline for candidates in a primary election.
