HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1150, L.D. 1550, Bill, "An Act to Reduce the Influence of Money in Elective Politics"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in subparagraph (1) in the 2nd line (page 1, line 47 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$500" and inserting in its place the following: '\$200'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in subparagraph (2) in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$300" and inserting in its place the following: '\$200'

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of subsection 2-A and inserting in its place the following:

'2-A. Political action committees. A political action committee may not make contributions aggregating more than \$500 per candidate per election to a candidate for Governor, state Senate or state House of Representatives.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the limits on aggregate contributions that individuals, corporations, associations and committees, except party committees, political action committees and candidate's authorized committees, may make to a candidate for Governor or to a candidate for state Senator to \$200 per election.

This amendment provides that a political action committee may not make contributions aggregating more than \$500 per
