SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1150, L.D. 1550, Bill, "An Act to Reduce the Influence of Money in Elective Politics"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in subparagraph (1) in the 2nd line (page 1, line 47 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$500" and inserting in its place the following: '\$1,000'


Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in subparagraph (2) in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$300" and inserting in its place the following: '\$800'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in subparagraph (3) in the 2nd line (page 2, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$200" and inserting in its place the following: '\$300'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the limits on aggregate contributions that individuals, corporations, associations and committees, except party committees, political action committees and candidate's authorized committees, may make to candidates to the following amounts per election: \$1,000 to a candidate for Governor; \$800 to a candidate for state Senator; and \$300 to a candidate for state Representative.
