
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1162, L.D. 1560, Bill, "An Act Requiring Public Schools to Purchase Insurance through a Competitive Bidding Process"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 14 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (4) (page 2, lines 10 to 12 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'(4) The line of insurance is workers' compensation or an employee benefit such as life or disability insurance in accordance with subsection 5. The requirement of competitive bidding may not be waived by a school board when the line of insurance is health insurance.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires public schools to purchase health insurance through the competitive bidding process established in the bill.
