COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1177, L.D. 1568, Bill, "An Act to Allow Nonresidents to Possess Antique License Plates"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §114, first ¶, as amended by PL 1989, c. 481, Pt. A, §6, is further amended to read:

The registration of an antique auto, antique motorcycle, horseless carriage or street rod as defined in this Title shall must be upon a form prescribed by the Secretary of State. The registration shall must be accompanied by an affidavit, provided by the Secretary of State, which shall must include a statement of the age and intended use of the motor vehicle and that ~~the applicant is a resident of~~ the vehicle is garaged or maintained in the State. Any person registering a street rod shall furnish proof that the vehicle is a valid street rod as provided in this section.

FISCAL NOTE

Eliminating the residency requirement for antique vehicles and allowing the registration of an antique vehicle garaged or

STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This amendment replaces the original bill. This amendment
9 changes the existing statute concerning the registration of an
10 antique vehicle by removing the requirement that an applicant for
11 an antique vehicle registration be a resident. Instead, it
12 requires that the vehicle be garaged or maintained in the State.
13 The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
