COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 551, L.D. 1575, Bill, "An Act to Amend Certain Provisions of Law Pertaining to Brewers' Licenses"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph C and inserting in its place the following:

'C. The holder of a brewery license may sell on the brewery premises during regular business hours to nonlicensees only a specialty package of malt liquor produced at the brewery, the. The volume of which is the specialty package may not ~~to exceed one-gallon,~~ to 5 liters and must be consumed off the premises.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment allows retail brewers to sell 5 liters of the brewers' product on the brewery premises for consumption off the premises. The amendment also limits the 5-liter sales on the brewery premises to nonlicensees only.
