2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355, sub-§1-A, ¶C,** as repealed and  
replaced by PL 1987, c. 623, §15, is amended to read:

6 C. The holder of a brewery license may sell on the brewery  
8 premises during regular business hours a specialty package  
of malt liquor produced at the brewery, the volume of which  
10 is not to exceed ~~one-gallon~~ 15 1/2 gallons, to be consumed  
off the premises.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill allows retail brewers to sell 15 1/2 gallons of  
18 their product on brewery premises instead of the current one  
gallon.
