Resolve, Regarding the Sale of State-owned Property.

Sec. 1. Commissioner of Defense and Veterans' Services; authority to megotiate and convey property. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Defense and Veterans' Services may negotiate with George F. Bryant and Janet A. Bryant for the sale and subsequent conveyance by deed of the interest of the State in a certain parcel of land in the Town of Millinocket, described as follows:

Beginning at a found iron pipe flush with the ground, said pipe marking the southeast corner of Lot 2 Block 58, Plan Book 14, Page 19, and the southwest corner of Lot 13, Block 58, Plan Book 14, Page 19; thence S 72° 24' 30" E along the south line of Lot 13 Block 58 twenty-three and eight tenths (23.8') feet to a point opposite an angle point in a wooden fence; thence S 53° 49' 45" E nineteen and one tenth (19.1') feet to the southwest corner of a garage; thence S 72° 34' 00" E along the south wall of said garage twenty-two and five tenths (22.5') feet to the southeast corner of garage and the concrete retaining wall; thence S 63° 10' 45" E along the south side of the retaining wall to its end and continuing for a total distance of thirty-six and five tenths (36.5') feet to the west side of Congress Street; thence northerly along the west side of Congress Street eleven and nine tenths (11.9') feet to the corner of Lot 13 Block 58; thence westerly along the south line of Lot 13 Block 58 one hundred (100') feet to the point of beginning. Bearings are magnetic in the year 1993.

The above-described premises are a portion of Lot numbered twelve (12), in Block number fifty-eight (58), as laid down on a Plan of Land of Great Northern Paper Company at Millinocket, in the County of Penobscot, State of Maine, and recorded in Penobscot Registry of Deeds in Plan Book No. 14, Page 35, January 9, 1946.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes the Commissioner of Defense and Veterans' Services to negotiate with George F. and Janet A. Bryant for the sale and subsequent conveyance by deed of a certain parcel of land in the Town of Millinocket.
