

4       Protection to prepare a petition, for the Governor's signature,  
6       sufficient to satisfy United States Environmental Protection  
      Agency's requirements to remove the State from the Ozone  
      Transport Region.

8       The Governor is required to submit this petition to the  
10      United States Environmental Protection Agency within 2 weeks of  
      receipt from the department.
