An Act Concerning the Hauling of Mobile Homes on the Roads and Highways of the State.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §832, as amended by PL 1989, c. 481, Pt. A, §22, is further amended by adding a new 2nd paragraph to read:**

6 Notwithstanding the first paragraph, a trailer or mobile
8 home dealer, licensed pursuant to section 359, who certifies to
10 the Secretary of State that the dealer does not haul mobile homes
12 on the public roads and highways of the State is not required to
14 file certification of liability insurance or surety bond and may
16 not issue temporary plates or dealer plates or haul mobile homes.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill allows the Secretary of State to waive the
18 insurance requirement for a mobile home dealer if the dealer
20 certifies that the dealer does not haul mobile homes on public
22 roads and highways.
