COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1198, L.D. 1606, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Charter of the Portland Water District"

Amend the bill by inserting before the emergency preamble the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 3rd line from the end (page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "significant"

Further amend by bill by striking out all of section 3 (page 2, lines 17 to 21 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires 9 municipalities to hold certain elections relative to their membership in the Portland Water

2 District. The additional costs of this state mandate are likely
4 to be minor. Pursuant to the mandate preamble, the 2/3 vote of
6 all members elected to each House exempts the State from the
8 constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local
10 costs.'
