SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1201, L.D. 1609, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Maine Election Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 38 (page 12, lines 45 and 46 and page 13 lines 1 to 20 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note (page 13, lines 26 to 39 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill includes statutory language implementing the National Voter Registration Act. The estimated cost of this unfunded federal mandate is \$16,570 for fiscal year 1994-95. No funding is provided for this purpose.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the General Fund appropriation from the bill and replaces the fiscal note.
