18 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1202, L.D. 1611, Bill, "An 20 Act to Adjust the Dates for Distributions from the State Harness Racing Commission"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this legislation provides for the distribution of commissions on wagers and requires certain distributions by May 15; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §275-I, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 388, 44 §8, is amended to read:

3. Distribution based on race dates. Payments made under subsections 1 and 2 for distribution in accordance with this
subsection must be divided-equally distributed among licensees

conducting live racing in the State in proportion to the number of racing-days-granted-by-the-commission-and-actually-raced-by that-licensee-and-the-total-number-of-racing-days-granted-in-any ene-year--by-the-commission-and-actually-raced-by-all-licensees days each licensee is both licensed to be and is open for wagering during the year in which the payments are made. Payment must-be-made-by-the-end-of-the-calendar-year. Payments made for wagers accepted before May 1st must be distributed not later than May 15th among all licensees in proportion to the number of days they are licensed to accept wagers for the entire year. Payments made for wagers accepted after April 30th and before September 1st must be distributed not later than September 15th. Payments made for wagers accepted after August 31st and on or before December 31st must be distributed among licensees so that the total distribution under this subsection to each licensee for the entire year is in proportion to the number of days each licensee was licensed to and did in fact accept wagers.

Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §275-J, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 388, 20 §8, is amended to read:

22 Distribution based on wagered amounts. Amounts On May З. 15th, September 15th and within 15 days after the close of all 24 off-track betting facilities for the year, amounts payable under subsections 1 and 2 for distribution in accordance with this 26 subsection must be divided -- equally -- among distributed to commercial race tracks in the State that provide simulcast 28 transmission of live racing in the State in proportion to the amount of wagers placed at off-track betting facilities on 30 simulcast races from that licensee in-the-previous-calendar-year up to the last day of the preceding month and the total amount 32 wagered at off-track betting facilities on races simulcast from all commercial racetracks in-that-year up to that date. In-the 34 first-year-of-distribution, - the -amounts -must -be-distributed-based en-the-proportion-of-wagers-made-in-that-first-year. The last 36 payment of the calendar year must be adjusted to reflect each licensee's wagers in proportion to the total wagered at off-track betting facilities in that calendar year. 38

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 44 statement of fact the following:

The State Harness Racing Commission will incur some minor additional costs to administer the redistribution of certain

supplement purses. These costs can be absorbed within the commission's existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment alters the method of distributing purse supplement money to provide that wagers are distributed based on the number of days a licensee is open for wagering, not on the number of days the licensee conducts live racing, and provides for 3 payments during the calendar year instead of one payment at the end of the year. The amendment also changes the method of paying purse supplements for tracks that originate simulcast races by basing the distribution on wagers placed on those simulcasts in the year of payment rather than the previous year, and providing for 3 payments during the year.
