An Act to Adjust the Dates for Distributions from the State Harness Racing Commission.

Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 26. Received by the Clerk of the House on December 29, 1993. Referred to the Committee on Agriculture and 1200 ordered printed pursuant to Joint Rule 14.

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 8 MRSA  $\S275$ -I, sub- $\S3$ , as enacted by PL 1993, c. 388,  $\S8$ , is amended to read:

- 3. Distribution based on race dates. Payments made under subsections 1 and 2 for distribution in accordance with this subsection must be divided equally among licensees conducting live racing in the State in proportion to the number of racing days granted by the commission and—actually—raced—by—that licensee and the total number of racing days granted in any one year by the commission and—actually—raced—by—all—licensees. Payment One third of the payment due for the total year must be made by—the—end on May 1st, September 1st and December 31st of the each calendar year. In addition, the December payment must be adjusted to reflect days actually raced during that year, as opposed to days granted.
- Sec. 2. 8 MRSA  $\S275$ -J, sub- $\S3$ , as enacted by PL 1993, c. 388,  $\S8$ , is amended to read:
- 3. Distribution based on wagered amounts. Amounts On May 1st, September 1st and December 31st of each calendar year, amounts payable under subsections 1 and 2 for distribution in accordance with this subsection must be divided equally among commercial race tracks in the State that provide simulcast transmission of live racing in the State in proportion to the amount of wagers placed at off-track betting facilities on simulcast races from that licensee in-the-previous-calendar-year up to the payment date and the total amount wagered at off-track betting facilities on races simulcast from all commercial racetracks in up to that year date. #### STATEMENT OF FACT

Under current law, distributions from the State Harness Racing Commission to racetracks to supplement purses are based on days actually raced and must be made at the end of the year in which the racing that was used to compute the distributions took place. This bill provides for these payments to be made in 3 equal installments based on assigned racing dates. The final installment is to be adjusted to reflect days actually raced.

Under current law, distributions from the State Harness Racing Commission due to commercial racetracks that provide simulcast transmission of live racing within the State reflect

the wagering of the previous year. With the exception of the first year, no distribution date is specified in the law. This bill requires that distributions be made 3 times a year to reflect the amounts wagered that year up to the date of each payment.
