COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to S.P. 576, L.D. 1620 2 Provides for the appropriation of funds to reinstate the medical eye care program within the Bureau of Medical Services.' Δ Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 6 statement of fact the following: 8 **'FISCAL NOTE** 10 1994-95 12 APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS 14 16 General Fund \$300,000 This amendment reinstates a statutory provision directing 18 the Department of Human Services to operate the medical eye care 20 program within the funds appropriated for that purpose and provides a General Fund appropriation of \$300,000 in fiscal year 1994-95. The full cost to reinstate this program is estimated to 22 be in excess of \$500,000 annually.' 24 26 STATEMENT OF FACT 28 This amendment appropriates \$300,000 from the General Fund in fiscal year 1994-95 to reinstate the medical eye care program, 30 limits the liability of the program to funds appropriated by the Legislature and adds a fiscal note to the bill. This amendment 32 also conforms existing law to current drafting standards.
