COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 577, L.D. 1621, Bill, "An Act to Protect Utility Consumers from Bearing Responsibility for Utility Mismanagement"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Shall" the following: to a level within the commission's discretion.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes clear that the Public Utilities Commission has full discretion in determining the level of its scrutiny of utility management practices in its determination of just and reasonable rates.
