Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §4, as amended by PL 1991, c. 626, §6, is further amended to read:

§4. Directors of bureaus

26

Each The Division of Veterans' Services and each bureau of the department must have a director. The Director of the Military Bureau, the Director of Operations of the Division of Veterans' Services and the Director of the Maine Emergency Management Agency must are each be appointed by the Adjutant General and shall serve at the pleasure of the Adjutant General. These directors may not hold any other state office for compensation. If the Adjutant General is unable to act, the Director of the Military Bureau has the civilian administrative powers and duties of the Adjutant General in the Adjutant General's capacity as Commissioner of Defense and Veterans' Services. The Director of the Military Bureau may also perform other civilian duties of the Adjutant General as assigned by the Adjutant General or the Governor.'
