

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-N is enacted to read:

6 §3174-N. Pastoral counselors

8 By October 1, 1994, the department shall adopt rules to
10 provide direct Medicaid reimbursement to licensed pastoral
12 counselors who provide counseling services to Medicaid recipients.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill directs the Department of Human Services to adopt
18 rules to provide direct Medicaid reimbursement to licensed
20 pastoral counselors.
